### WHAT IS TBRI®?

TBRI® is an attachment-based, trauma-informed intervention designed to meet the complex needs of vulnerable children or children who have experienced trauma, neglect or abuse. TBRI® addresses the child's physical needs, attachment needs, and tools to disarm fear-based behaviors. TBRI is based on years of attachment, sensory processing, and neuroscience research.

The TBRI® Overview Class is a glimpse into the three TBRI® PRINCIPLES

1. Connection—attention to attachment needs
2. Empowerment—attention to physical needs
3. Correction—attention to behavioral needs
